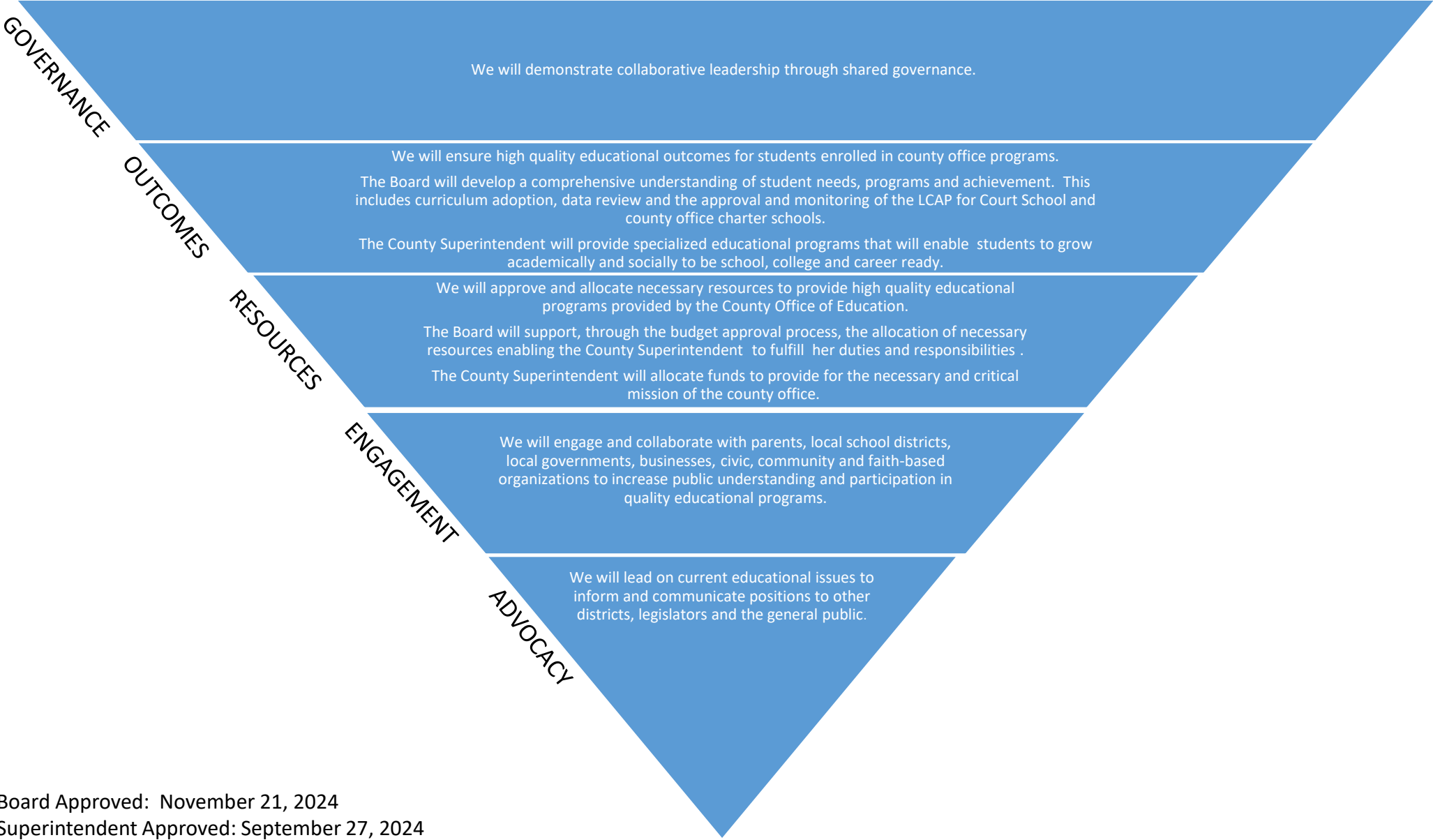

Board of Education Objectives (3 Year Goals)

• **GOVERNANCE**

- County Board members will serve as liaisons to provide meaningful input within the area of the board's responsibility. Board liaisons will meet with staff at each stage of development and report on progress and/or outcomes at board meetings.
- The County Board will review expulsion and interdistrict transfer Education Code, review policies and handbooks, and apply policy to appeals brought to the Board.
- The County Board will support the implementation of a student board member position.

• **STUDENT OUTCOMES**

- The Board will prioritize accelerating learning and achievement in Pathways Charter School. Through its liaisons, the Board will monitor the clear and measurable outcome targets and ensure fiscal support for innovative programs.
- Through its liaisons, the County Board will oversee the outcomes of students in Honour Schaps court school that have been prioritized to students' educational, emotional, and workforce needs and addressed via through credit recovery, career exploration, and interagency collaboration.
- The County Board will be informed, support, and advocate for programs on student behavioral health and wellness.
- The County Board will be informed, support and advocate for a community-based literacy initiative to improve literacy outcomes in Placer County.

• **RESOURCES**

- The County Board is committed to responsible stewardship of public funds and will monitor fiscal practices and approve a budget that ensures the effective use of resources.

• **COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT**

- The County Board will foster collaboration and partnerships among community-based organizations to support the educational goals of the Placer County Office of Education.
- The County Board will participate in activities and events to support districts, schools and students in Placer County.
- The County Board will support family engagement in PCOE education programs.
- The County Board will build a strong, collaborative relationship between county board members, district superintendents, and local board members to address educational priorities, support student achievement, and ensure school needs are met through cohesive county-wide strategies.

• **ADVOCACY**

- The County Board will advocate for students in PCOE programs and public education. The County Board will align its advocacy efforts with the five Advocacy Pillars established by the County Board.
