Principal's Message

Dear iLearn Families and Community,

Here is a quick, friendly Valentine's message that serves as a yearly reminder to help students stay focused on academics at school:

Cell Phones & Smartwatches

- Cell phones and other electronic signaling devices (i.e., smartwatches) must be off and in their backpack during school hours. The cell phone or smartwatch may be used if it is approved by a school staff member and for a supervised school activity. Students are always allowed to use their cellphones or smartwatches in the case of an emergency, in response to a perceived threat of danger, as allowed by a teacher, administrator, doctor, or the student's individualized education program.

Recently, I have seen an increase in the number of smartwatches on students (especially after the winter break). In the past, I have told students to place their smartwatches on "school mode", but recently I was made aware that putting a smartwatch on school mode includes the following:

- Students can take a smartwatch out of school mode at any time
- Parents must set Schooltime on their students' watches by using their cell phones
- Students can take a smartwatch out of school mode at any time (repeated for emphasis)

As our policy states, cell phones AND smartwatches must be off and in backpacks during school hours. If a student is seen with either, they will be required to bring it to the office and can pick it up at the end of the day. After the second occurrence, a parent will need to come to the school and pick them up, with the student and principal present. If there is a third occurrence, the student will not be able to have a cell phone or smartwatch on campus at all.

If you need to contact your students while they are at school, please call the school directly. If students need to call home or contact you from school, they must do so from the school office. We have actual telephones with wires and everything, just like it's 1985 all over again, and they really work!
